Comm. Bostwick motioned to approve the agenda. Comm. Reed seconded, and the motion carried.

Approve Minutes – August 15, 2016

Introduction of new Parks & Recreation Commissioner – Larry Laehn

The commission requested the stop sign on Parkview Drive at the Parker YMCA be on the next agenda.


Next Meeting Date – October 17, 2016
