PROGRAMMING & ACTIVITIES

I attended meetings with: city department heads, city council, and library staff.

The Library received the following reimbursements from Rock, Jefferson, and Dane Counties for circulation from their township users in 2016.

Rock County = \$85,266.41 (last year: \$ 74,575)

Dane County = \$939.00 (last year: \$ 580)

Jefferson County = \$3,185 (last year: \$ 2,327)

[Beginning in 2008, counties are required by Wisconsin Statutes to pay each municipal and joint public library within the county as well as all adjacent counties at least 70 percent of the cost of library services provided to residents of the county who do not maintain a public library.]
