

PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION AND RECEIPTS

Payments will no longer be processed at the City of Milton as Rock County is collecting the first and second installments of real estate property taxes. Payments will NOT be accepted at City Hall.

The following are the instructions for paying your 2016 property tax bill:

- Property tax receipts will not be mailed unless a self-addressed stamped envelope is enclosed with payment. Additional payment options (including online payments) are shown on the Rock County Treasurer's website:

It is highly encouraged to pay electronically to avoid mail delays and Electronic checks only cost \$1.00 and multiple parcels can be paid in one transaction. **First installments are due January 31, 2017.**

- If mailing your payment, checks should be mailed and made out to:

Be sure to include the Tax ID number with payment

The Rock County Treasurer's Office will be closed on December 23 and 26 and January 2. Office hours are 8am to 5pm (Monday – Friday).






To view your tax bill online:

- In the upper right hand corner, a hyperlink is available for viewing your 2014-2016 property tax bills.

KEY 2017 CITY BUDGET FACTORS

- Continuation of service from previous years with no service reductions
- Budget levies (collects) less tax dollars than in 2016
- Total budgeted expenditures increased by less 0.75%
- No planned borrowing in budget
